RANGE SAFETY RULES

1. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the course at any time.
2. Anyone suspected of being impaired will be asked to leave. This is a judgment call by the officers present.
3. Archers will shoot only in designated areas. Broadheads will only be shot in the broadhead pit.
4. While shooting the course, archers will follow the designated trail. No short cuts permitted, even if a target has been passed up.
5. Archers will leave one person of their group at the designated shooting point while recovering arrows. This will ensure the following group knows people are still in the target area.
6. A maximum of two minutes is allowed to search for lost arrows.
7. Anytime an unsafe act is observed, a call of "CEASE FIRE" will be made. Once the problem is corrected, call out "ALL CLEAR" and resume shooting.
8. Report safety violations to any Club Official or Field Captain.
9. If in doubt, don't shoot! Don't be afraid to ask if a target is "ALL CLEAR." Communicate and be safe.
10. When drawing a bow back there can be no excessive movement, such as swinging left, right, or up. Shooters who do so may be disqualified and asked to leave the range.
