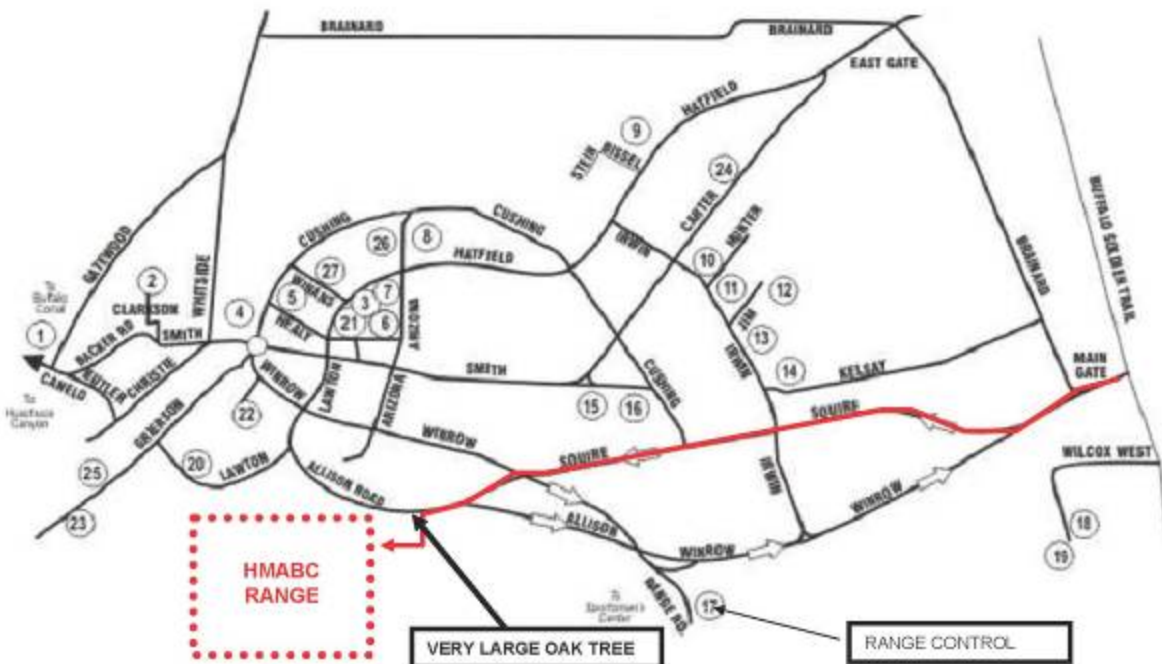

Directions to Fort Huachuca: Fort Huachuca is located 74 miles South of Tucson. Travel I-10 to Benson (Exit 302, Highway 90 South). Proceed south approximately 30 miles to Sierra Vista/Fort Huachuca. Turn on to Fort Huachuca and proceed to the vehicle registration office just before the main gate (get in the right lane and pull into the parking lot of the registration office). To gain access to Fort Huachuca you will need; picture I.D., driver's license, registration, and proof of current insurance.



From the Ft Huachuca Main Gate, follow Squire Avenue (one way road) to the intersection with Winrow (1.9 miles). Get into the left lane, go through the intersection (Yield Sign), and continue straight across and down the hill – the road curves to the right. From the bottom of the hill, go approximately 200 yards to the very large oak tree on the left. Turn left at that tree and go up the hill approximately 150 yards – the clubhouse is 150 yards to the right.
